The Mill Valley Fire Department is seeking highly energetic and motivated candidates for the entry-level position of Firefighter-Trainee. Under supervision, the Firefighter-Trainee is expected to function on an engine company or an ALS ambulance assigned to prevent, control, and extinguish fires, perform basic life support medical care, perform rescue operations and maintenance duties. The Firefighter-Trainee is also expected to exercise initiative and some independent decision-making for assigned work details, carry out all instructions, directives, lawful orders, and participate in department training activities.

The Mill Valley Fire Department serves approximately 14,000 people with two fire stations, and responds to approximately 2000 calls for service annually. The City of Mill Valley is located 11 miles north of San Francisco and encompasses the hillsides and canyons of Mount Tamalpais. In addition to firefighting and emergency medicine, the Mill Valley Fire Department members are specialized in a wide range of skills including fire investigations, technical rescue, working with Community Emergency Response Teams, CPR, business inspections and weed abatements.
